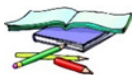

1 x electronic metronome (optional)

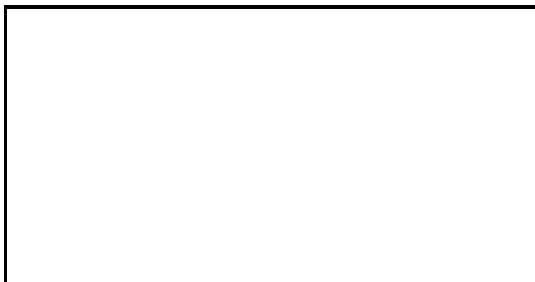
Subject music - grade theory book

NOTES :

An attempt has been made to present a comprehensive list so that very few items will need to be purchased in the new year.

Sufficient folio must be provided for subjects requiring files. Ring reinforcements are recommended but are not compulsory.

Some teachers will make a further request for plastic filing sleeves. Do not purchase any in advance.

Requirements for projects will be given during the course of the year for all subjects.

Pupils may choose to purchase large lever arch files in place of others which have been requested. Old files are obviously acceptable.

All textbooks and hard cover books should be covered in plastic or contact and clearly labelled.

In cases where a lever arch file is requested, you may purchase an A4, 3 quire hard cover book in its place. These books must be kept from Grade 8 to Grade 12.

A flash drive (4 GB or more) is highly recommended.

It is recommended that you do not purchase all the exam pads as indicated in the stationery list straight away as they may not all be required.

Grade 9 pupils may use the same 30 pocket flip file that they used in Grade 8 for Afrikaans and English.
