Matric results 2020

Our most sincere congratulations to the Matric class of 2020. We are very proud of you and of the results that you have achieved.

We fielded 242 candidates. Of our candidates, 169 achieved a Bachelor's pass, 48 achieved a Diploma pass and 5 received a higher certificate.

The following 14 Alexans achieved an A aggregate:

Among these spectacular results are 41 subject marks that are over 90%!

In total, the Matrics managed to amass 230 subject distinctions.

115 Matrics achieved an average of 60% or above

The following Subject Heads and teachers are very proud of their pupils:

Dramatic Arts, where 61% of the grade achieved a distinction,

65% of the grade achieved an A or a B and the lowest mark was above 50%;

Life Orientation, where 30% of the Grade achieved a distinction;
Visual Art, where 30% of the grade achieved a distinction;
Information Technology, where 21% achieved a distinction and 42% achieved either an A or a B;
isiXhosa, where 35% of the grade achieved a distinction and 57% achieved either an A or a B;
Afrikaans, where 21% of the grade achieved a distinction and 44% achieved either an A or a B.

These are remarkable achievements, demonstrating the incredible focus of our teachers to the task of getting everyone to achieve their potential.

Sadly, several of our Matrics did not make the grade this year. Some have elected to rewrite some subjects in July. While they may not have a certificate today, we are still very proud of them all. They are Alexans and always will be.

After the year that the class of 2020 faced, they are to be commended on the perseverance that they demonstrated last year.
