## **SGB by-elections and an action-packed week**

The request is for a six-month stay with the possibility of an extension to 10 months, starting from August 2022. We have had a fantastic response to our call for used cooking oil. Please don't throw used oil down the drain or send it to the municipal landfill. Oil is very polluting in both situations. Thanks to those who have sent oil so far. Please send us your used oil so that we can ensure that it enters the sustainable cycle of being used for biodiesel and cleaning products.

My sincere gratitude to all the families who have met their financial commitments to the school so far this year. Your dedication to this unenviable task is what allows us to do what we need to. If you face challenges with paying fees, please don't ignore the problem. Please contact us to address the situation. We have found that a collaboration is the best way to face these difficulties and generally yields less pain.

This is particularly important in the morning when the flow is at its peak. Please do not do a U turn in Alexander Road or park at an angle in the allocated drop-and-go areas.
